THEATER HISTORY

On August 1, 1967 Bulat Ayukhanov founded first in the history of culture and art, not only in Kazakhstan but also in the Soviet Union ensemble of choreographic miniatures "Young Ballet of Alma-Ata".

Founded on August 1, 1967, the theatre is cradle of ballet art and since its foundation has been doing a lot of work to popularize the best creative achievements of dance art. The theatre has successfully toured all Soviet Union republics, performed on stages of the best theatres of GDR, in West Berlin, Sweden, Finland, India, France, Iraq, Italy, Jordan, Hungary, Syria, Turkey, England. The theatre continues to conduct touring and concert activities throughout the country and abroad, developing new programs and concepts, distributing and implementing them with the help of all possible types of public relations. New forms are being developed and implemented that expand

the public's interest in ballet art. The concert activity of theatre artists, leading soloists in all events of the national and international level, is diverse and rich. In 2003, Bulat Ayukhanov's troupe received status

of State Academic Theatre of Dance of the **Republic of Kazakhstan, which occupies special** place in cultural life of our country. **Currently, Theatre of Dance is recognizable brand** both in Kazakhstan and abroad, whose repertoire includes more than 250 ballet performances and separate concert items.

Action I Picture I

Snowy plain on the background of icy mountains is domain of The Snow Queen. Snowflakes are circling, wind is getting stronger, the snow queen appears, with her two faithful trolls. The queen conjures, a magic mirror appears. Through this mirror, the snow queen observes human world. Suddenly a scarlet rose appears in the mirror. The Snow Queen is angry. She hates all living things, especially flowers. The Snow Queen, in her anger, breaks magic mirror and the pieces scatter all over the earth.

Picture II

The street. Winter morning. Children play funny games, among them Kai and Gerda, inseparable friends. Kai gives Gerda a scarlet living rose as a sign of devoted friendship. Gerda is very happy with such a gift, she loves fresh flowers, especially roses. The trolls are watching. They spy on the instructions of The Snow Queen, look for the people who love flowers and report everything to The **Snow Queen.**

A strong wind rises, turmoil begins. Kai and Gerda lost sight of each other. Kai gets a fragment of a magic mirror in his eye, it hurts him. The Snow Queen appears, she likes Kai and she decides to take him with her. The trolls, on the orders of The Snow Queen, grab Kai and take him with them to the realm of The Snow Queen. Gerda is looking for Kai. Friends who saw how Kai was kidnapped show Gerda the way. Gerda decides to bring Kai back and rushes to his aid.

Picture III

Gerda runs in footsteps of The Snow

Queen in search of her beloved friend Kai. Getting out of her strength, Gerda realizes that she is lost. Gerda is very scared. Suddenly a nice old lady appears. She invites Gerda to her house to rest after the journey.

Picture IV

Flower garden. Old woman has a nice garden with many beautiful flowers. These flowers can talk and dance. Gerda dances with flowers and falls asleep, forgetting about Kai. In a dream, Gerda sees Kai. They play as before and he gives her a scarlet rose. Gerda wakes up. She remembered that she needed to hurry. Gerda runs away from the nice garden further in search of Kai.

Action II Picture V

The trolls of The Snow Queen interfere

with Gerda in search of Kai and they succeed. Gerda again lost her way, in despair she cries bitterly. Suddenly a black crow appears. He is very elegant and polite because he serves in the palace. After listening to the story of Gerda, the raven decides to take her to the palace, to introduce Gerda to the prince, princess and all the courtiers.

Picture VI

Ball in the palace. The courtiers meet the prince and princess. Solemn dance begins. At the end of dance, the prince gives the princess a golden rose. At this moment, Gerda runs out and runs to the prince. Gerda thought it was Kai, but she made a mistake. Gerda is crying again. The prince and princess comfort her, give her gifts, give her servants, and send her further in search of Kai.

Picture VII

Night. Forest. The robbers are preparing a new robbery plan. Leader is a little robber girl joking with her tame reindeer, frightening him with a knife. All the robbers are very happy. Suddenly, the robbers hear that someone is approaching. What luck! They decide to set up an ambush. They attack Gerda and take her as a prisoner. All the servants and the raven run away. Gerda in the hands of robbers. The robbers take away from Gerda the things presented to her in the palace.

The little robber takes away the rose given by Kai from Gerda, but throws it away. Flowers do not interest robbers. Gerda carefully picks up the rose and presses it to her chest. The little robber is surprised that this rose is so dear to Gerda, she asks to tell what brought her here at night to the dark forest. Hearing the sad story of Gerda, the robbers sympathize with her. The little robber girl decides to help poor Gerda. She returns all her belongings to her and gives her reindeer as a gift. The deer must take Gerda to the kingdom of The Snow Queen, where her beloved friend Kai is languishing! Gerda thanks the robbers from the bottom of her heart

and sets off on her journey.

Picture VIII

Blizzard. Kingdom of the Snow Queen. Gerda and the reindeer struggle to make their way. The deer falls down exhausted and cannot go further. Gerda leaves her warm clothes for the reindeer and goes on alone to look for Kai.

Picture IX

Palace of The Snow Queen. Ice Hall. Snowflakes and trolls dance for the snow queen. The snow queen tells the trolls to bring Kai. Kai has completely changed. He no longer laughs, no longer plays. He is only interested in watching the dance of snowflakes. Kai dances with the snow queen, obeying her in everything. The Snow Queen decided to make Kai the prince of snow kingdom. To do this, she wants to put a magical crown on his head so that his heart turns into a piece of ice. Suddenly Gerda runs in, runs to Kai and hugs him. Kai coldly pushes Gerda away. He is not at all happy about this long-awaited meeting, he does not recognize Gerda. Then Gerda takes out the rose that Kai gave her. The Snow Queen laughs. She offers Kai the crown. Become the prince of the snow kingdom. Kai holds a crown and a rose in his hands, he is faced with a choice. Kai can become the prince of entire snow kingdom or leave with Gerda. Suddenly, Kai pricked himself with a rose thorn and dropped it. Kai hurts. The queen laughs, she is sure of her victory. Then Gerda takes Kai's hand and kisses it. A miracle is happening! Kai remembers Gerda and hugs her tightly. Charms of The Snow Queen are powerless against sincere friendship and love! Snow kingdom, The Snow Queen and her retinue disappear.




Burlova Anna The Snow Queen


